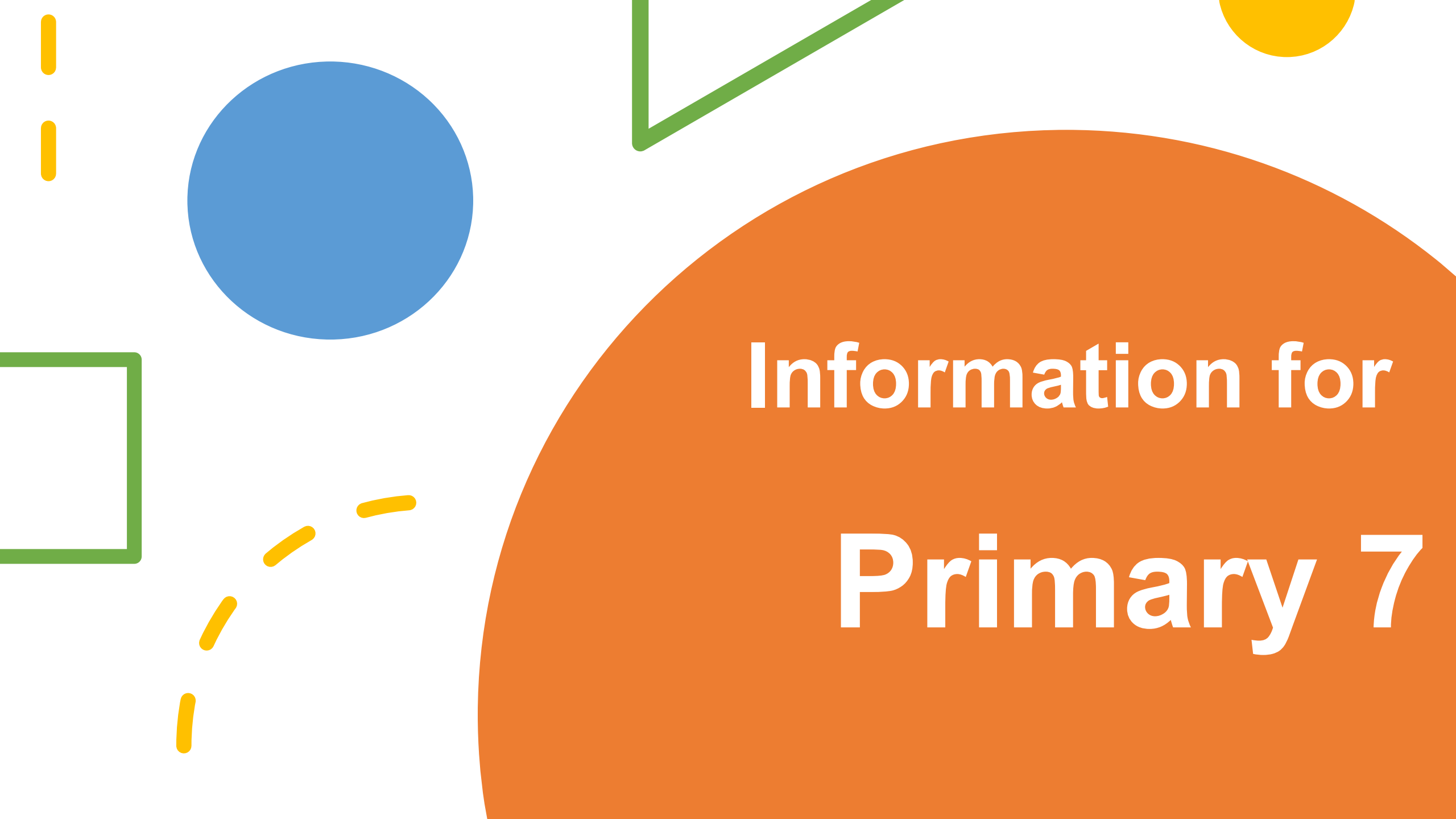

Revision

- Spelling and Tables should be practiced each night.
- Children should be reading for approx. **20 minutes** each night and recording reading in their Reading Log Books. Parents should sign Log Books each night.
- Homework must be signed, returned and completed to the best of your child's ability.
- SEAG children will receive 1 additional homework per week. This is in addition to class homework and is not an alternative.

Seesaw



- Homework will be uploaded to Seesaw each night - children will complete activities into homework books.
- Seesaw codes are stuck into the front cover of all homework diaries meaning codes are available should you need to log in and out of devices
- Please do check the 'Messages' section of Seesaw regularly as this is our main platform of communication with parents regarding trip information, notices and reminders.
 - The MySchoolApp should also be monitored regularly
- Any Information you need to communicate please send an email to myself or the office as Seesaw will not be monitored at all times



SEAG

- SEAG Practice Papers will be completed in school on **Tuesday** and **Thursday** mornings.
- Papers will be marked that day in class.
- A class average will be written on each paper to give an idea of how your child is performing comparatively.
- Papers will be sent home when they have been checked by teaching staff
- SEAG dates: **15th and 22nd November**
- Results issued: **24th January 2026**



SchoolMoney App

All school dinners and trips will be paid online using the SchoolMoney App.

If you have any issues accessing your SchoolMoney account, please contact the office.

At the beginning of the year, we provide children with a pack of essential stationery items which we top up during the year.

Parents have been asked for a £5 (per child) voluntary contribution towards stationery per term.

Behavioural Expectations

We follow a positive behaviour policy which can be viewed on the school website. This includes operation of a red/yellow/gold card system.

We use 'Class Dojo' in class. Children can earn/lose points based on choices made.

YELLOW CARD

You will most likely get a yellow card (warning) for the following:

Rough play (toy fights, pushing/pulling etc.)
Leaving people out of games
Ruining other people's games
Not carrying out instructions from staff
Taking too long to line up
Disruptive behaviour during line up
Leaving the playground without permission
Hanging around inside the corridors/toilets
Dropping litter
Running in the corridor

This is not an exhaustive list and staff may issue yellow cards for other reasons.

(A yellow card will result in 'time out' within a play time period. This card will stay with a pupil for 5 school days. Another offence within this time period will result in a red card. If the period lapses without a further offence, the card is removed.)

RED CARD

You will most likely get a red card (sanction) for the following:

Fighting
Bullying
Disrespect to staff
Damaging property
Causing danger to people (including staff)
Bad language
2 yellow cards

Staff can give immediate red cards for any offence which they see as serious - it does not need to be on the above list.

(Any red card offence will be recorded in the Incident Book and parents informed. Red cards will also result in a ~~one~~ detention the following Thursday.)

- If your child requires an inhaler, please send in a **named** inhaler to be kept in school.
