Staff – Mrs Millar (Monday, Tuesday and Wednesday)

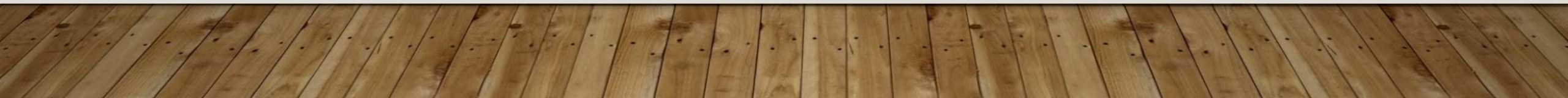
Mrs Brown (Thursday and Friday)

HOMEWORK / READING

- Written homework will begin Monday 8th September
- One Literacy and one Numeracy homework
- Receive on Monday and return by Thursday
- Grouping for reading is constantly under review. Once appropriate checks have been completed children will receive their reading book. We aim for two books per week for P2.
- Practice and encouragement are essential to build up your child's confidence. It is very important to read and talk about books with your child, including those outside of our reading schemes.

CONCERN FORMS

- These will be monitored closely during the next few weeks with more discussion during October interviews.

- Early intervention is key

BEHAVIOUR

- Age-appropriate behaviour is expected; however, we help and nurture each child to become their best possible self.
- Adults act as role models and are sensitive to each child's needs. We ensure positive reinforcement as we encounter daily difficulties.
- Incentives and rewards – timers, golden time, button jars, pupil of the week, table points
- Parental support is so important, and we really value your input so please do not hesitate to get in touch with any worries or concerns
